Transportation Research Institute will host U.S. Transportation Secretary Ray Lahood, Gov. Rick Snyder and industry and community leaders to launch the deployment of the U.S Dept. of Transportation's Connected Vehicle Safety Pilot on Aug. 23.

The first of its kind effort will test a Wi-Fi-like technology that allows vehicles and highway infrastructure to communicate with each other and could help reduce crashes and improve traffic congestion.

The U-M Transportation Research Institute will conduct the year-long project in Ann Arbor where nearly 3,000 cars, trucks and buses equipped with vehicle-to-vehicle and vehicle-toinfrastructure devices.
