

This integrated climate module combines the heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) unit with the refrigerant system, including an energy-efficient heat pump.

Its position outside the cabin allows for new interior design options, including an easy user experience with the vehicle's electronics and comfort features, all of which are designed to mitigate distraction.

"From its driver interface to its compact and innovative climate system, the e-Bee is an exercise in efficient, forward-looking design for new mobility uses," Yerdon said.

"The vehicle will be showcased at customer and industry events throughout Asia, the U.S. and Europe, where it will be the centerpiece in Visteon's discussions with customers and partners about future technology trends and needs."

In 2011, the Chevy Impala was inch color display screen and the best-selling full-size sedan in America, selling more than 170,000 units. Next spring, Chevy will begin selling the all-new 2014 Impala with a starting price tag of \$27,535.

The new Impala will have several new features, including Adaptive Cruise Control and technologies crash-avoidance like Rear Cross Traffic Alert and Side Blind Zone Alert.

The 2014 Impala will also debut Chevrolet's latest MyLink radio, with a customizable eightnatural voice recognition.

The all-new Impala will be the 10th generation of the popular nameplate, and will be offered in LS, LT, and LTZ trim levels. The 3.6L, 305-horsepower engine will hit dealer showrooms first, with a starting price of \$30,760 for the LT and \$36,580 for the LTZ. The 2.5L engine will be \$27,535 for the LS, \$29,785 for the LT, and \$34,555 for the LTZ; pricing for the 2.4L engine will be announced later.





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
