Diesels Cheaper to Operate The majority of American con-Among cost-savings advansumers have not been sold on tages for clean diesel the study

the virtues of diesel-powered automobiles, but a new study indicates motorists may want to give today's clean diesels a second look.

The study, entitled Total Cost of Ownership: A Gas Versus Diesel Comparison was conducted for Robert Bosch LLC and released June 27 from the University of Michigan. According to an article published on that date in PR Newswire, the study found that diesel vehicles saved owners between \$2,000 and \$6,000 in total ownership costs during a threeto five-year period when compared to a similar gasoline-powered vehicle.

Overall, the results of our analyses show that diesel vehicles provide owners with a TCO (total cost of ownership) that is less than that of the gas versions of the same vehicles," according to the study. "The estimates of savings for three and five years of ownership vary from a low of \$67 in three years to a high of \$15,619 in five years, but most of the savings are in the \$2,000 to \$6,000 range, which also include the extra cost that is usually added to the diesel version of a vehicle."

Fuel efficiency has always been an advantage for dieselpowered vehicles, in fact, they are 20 to 40 percent more fuel efficient than gasoline-powered cars, so drivers save money even when the price of diesel rises slightly above gasoline in per-gallon price.

cited significant savings in total cost of ownership, fuel efficiency, fuel costs and depreciation over similar gasoline-powered vehi-

Allen Schaeffer, executive director of the Diesel Technology Forum, said the study's findings reinforce what auto analysts and other comparative studies have found and predicts sales of diesels will more than double in the U.S. over the next two years.

Schaeffer added that as the U.S. moves to the new fuel standard of 54.5 mpg by 2025, U.S. drivers will become even more aware of clean diesel advantages.
