GM's New \$1 Billion Investment Brings 1,500 Jobs to U.S.

General Motors revealed plans on Jan. 17 about how the compa- multiple new vehicle, advanced ny will invest an additional \$1 bil- technology and component projlion in U.S. manufacturing opera-

These investments follow the \$2.9 billion announced in 2016 and more than \$21 billion GM has invested in its U.S. operations since 2009, said GM spokeswoman Joanne Krell.

The new investments cover ects. A combination of 1,500 new and retained jobs are tied to the new investments. Details of individual projects will be announced throughout the year,

"These investment decisions have been in the works for quite a while," Krell said. "You just don't decide to do something like this in a short period of time.

GM will begin work on insourcing axle production for its nextgeneration full-size pickup trucks - including work previously done in Mexico - to operations in Michigan, creating 450 U.S. jobs, Krell said.

"As the U.S. manufacturing

base increases its competitiveness, we are able to further increase our investment, resulting in more jobs for America and better results for our owners," said GM Chairman and CEO Mary

"The U.S. is our home market and we are committed to growth that is good for our employees, dealers, and suppliers and supports our continued effort to drive shareholder value."

The details of the plan will not be released to the public at this time. Krell said.

"There is no timeline for when we will share the details, but they will be released to the public as the plans come close to being

General Motors Fined by SEC Over Ignitions

DETROIT (AP) - General Motors will pay the federal government a \$1 million civil penalty for violating accounting rules involving the company's deadly ignition switch scandal.

The penalty, announced Jan. 19 as a settlement with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission, is for failing to have accounting controls in place to determine the potential for a recall and estimate the possible loss.

GM said it consented to an SEC cease-and-desist order without admitting or denying any wrongdoing.

The order found that GM personnel knew in the spring of 2012 that the switches were a safety issue but failed to tell accountants until November of

Because of that, for at least 18 months, accountants didn't properly evaluate whether there would be a recall or the potential losses from the scandal, the agency said.

"Internal accounting controls at General Motors failed to consider relevant accounting guidance when it came to considering disclosure of potential vehicle recalls," Andrew Calamari, director of the SEC's New York regional office, said in a statement.

General Motors said in a statement that since the ignition switch problem, it has reorganized vehicle engineering teams for greater accountability and set up a new vehicle safety organization.

student with the U.S. Department of Labor

MAT2 is the state's effort to address Michigan's skills gaps in manufacturing by partnering with community colleges and local employers to offer free student apprenticeships.

MAT2 helps students avoid debt by earning tuition-free associate degrees while simultaneously getting paid to gain on-thejob experience in high-paying, high-demand, advanced manufacturing careers.


Employers have said recruiting young people into the trades and training them in their company's way of operating is a key value of the MAT2 program. There are now 122 MAT2 students and 44 companies across Michigan.

To make the MAT2 grant application process easier, business services staff with local Michigan

Works! agencies that partner with employers and will submit grant applications to the TIA on their behalf. Applications for MAT2 Grants may be submitted through Sept. 30, 2017.

Eligible companies that team with their local Michigan Works! agency will need to submit a copy of their MAT2 Employer Training Plan, proof of tuition payment and a copy of their firm's USDOL Certification Letter. The grant is a one-time award of \$5,000 per student.

The goal is to enlist more metro Detroit businesses into the program and recruit more students who recognize the importance of apprenticeships as the way to transfer knowledge and skills from retiring workers to new workers. To register for the webinar and learn more email wda-mat2@michigan.gov.





put into action," Krell said.

GM's announcement is part of the company's increased focus on overall efficiency over the last four years, Barra said. With a strategy to streamline and simplify its operations and grow its business, GM has created 25,000 jobs in the U.S. - approximately 19,000 engineering, IT and professional jobs and 6,000 hourly manufacturing jobs - and added nearly \$3 billion in annual wages and benefits to the U.S. economy over that period.

At the same time, GM reduced more than 15,000 positions outside the U.S., bringing most of those jobs to America, Barra said. During that period, the company moved from 90 percent of its IT work being outsourced to an insourced U.S.-based model.

"We will continue our commitment to driving a more efficient business," said Barra, "as shown by our insourcing of more than 6,000 IT jobs that were formerly outside the U.S., streamlining our engineering operations from seven to three, with the core engineering center being in Warren, Michigan, and building on our momentum at GM Financial and in advanced technologies. These moves, and others, are expected to result in more than 5,000 new jobs in the U.S. over the next few years."

GM has also been facilitating its supplier base to do the same, Bara said. The company has been executing a strategy to create supplier parks adjacent to its U.S. manufacturing sites (already accomplished at GM's Fairfax Assembly Plant in Kansas, Spring Hill Assembly Plant in Tennessee, Fort Wayne Assembly Plant in Indiana, and Lordstown

Assembly Plant in Ohio), and will continue to expand this effort, she said.

Supplier parks locating near assembly plants result in significant savings from reduced transportation costs, higher quality communications and continuous improvement activities as suppliers are located closer to the final assembly location, Barra said.

In addition, GM is confirming that another supplier has committed to make components for GM's next-generation full-size pickup trucks in Michigan, moving 100 supplier jobs from Mexico to the U.S.

in this hyper-competitive environment. We commend those that are working to improve their efforts in this area.'

GM was the fastest-growing full-line automaker in 2016 based on retail market share, which was up 0.5 percentage points to an estimated 16.8 percent, Cain said. Chevrolet continues to be the U.S. automotive industry's fastest-growing brand, he said, with retail market share up nearly 1 point in the past two years to 11.1 percent.

The Chevrolet Volt had its best sales year ever in 2016, with deliveries up 61 percent versus 2015. The GMC Yukon XL saw deliveries increase 18 percent in 2016, with more than 60 percent of customers purchasing Denali models.

Cadillac is also growing rapidly around the world.

GM Diversity Communications.

"Many of them had not been exposed to automotive journalism, had never been to Detroit or seen snow. But they brought with them the right amount of curiosity required to cover an event as massive and complex as the North American International Auto Show and they did so with grit and class.'

One student demonstrated that drive by chasing a face-toface interview with GM Chairman and CEO Mary Barra on the auto show floor, Bauza said.

Another coaxed GM North America President Alan Batev into a video that won the program's top prize: an all-expensepaid trip to a national journalism conference.

Students Rushawn Walters and Nia Muhammad, both of Howard University, and Sarah Rahal, of Wayne State University, won the prize with "Jammin' with GM," a video story told through carpool karaoke, focusing on the new Chevrolet Cruze and technologies such as Apple Car Play, Android Auto, Teen Driver, Rear Seat Reminder and the car's fuel economy.

"As an aspiring student journalist from Detroit, getting the opportunity to learn more about what's in my backyard was a priceless gift," said Rahal.

"This program gave me a network of people that are proficient in the industry and the knowledge to use it in the field. Discover Your Drive allowed me to believe that automotive news is a possibility for my future."

The students took part in a iournalism workshop led by Ray Suarez, former host of NPR's Talk

of the Nation, Bauza said. They also heard a panel on the state of diversity in newsrooms.

The panel, moderated by award-winning journalist Ed Gordon, featured fashion critic Michael Quintanilla, formerly of the Los Angeles Times and San Antonio Express News; political journalist Patricia Guadalupe, a contributing writer to NBC Latino; Walter Middlebrook, Detroit *News* assistant managing editor; and Salvador Rodriguez, Inc. magazine's tech reporter.

Students attended news conferences and vehicle reveals, explored the auto show floor and interviewed auto experts. The professional journalists mentored the students and helped them produce news stories and presentations. The program ended with an awards ceremony at the GM Heritage Center in Sterling Heights.

"As a diversity and business reporter, it's really great to see GM put its money and weight behind discovering and helping young journalists of diverse backgrounds get started with their careers," said Inc.'s Rodriguez, also a mentor.

Ouintanilla, a returning mentor whose team won last year, says news groups need to take note.

"This is the most original experience for college students that encourages them to consider automotive journalism while also promoting diversity in newsrooms," he said.

"By diverse, I mean not only diversity in one's ethnicity but also in ideas and a promise from everyone involved to protect and uphold journalism's existence and the profession's commitment to tell accurate and honest stories.'
